NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

1.1 Pews : Remove front pews and pew desks at east end from both blocks of pews to create a little more space. Refix pew desks in front of retained pews; this will mean cutting the one on the north side. Note wainscotting on south wall.

1.2 Floor : Removing the pews and pew platforms will expose the subfloor void. The platforms will need to be made good and the voids will need to be filled and paved.

There are some additional repairs required to stone floors in front of the altar, behind the font at the west end and in the porch.

2.9.1: Priest's door: repair
